Cassandra is distinctive because she hears every nuance of the music. In her dance she makes the music come alive, so that you actually hear it better while you're watching her. Also, she's enjoying herself and she communicates that enjoyment to everyone who's in the audience. You owe it to yourself to experience the number one reason why dancers, hobbyists and professionals, keep coming back to Oasis year after year - Cassandra!

Tamalyn Dallal established the "Mid Eastern Dance Exchange" in Miami Beach, through which has mentored thousands of dancers around the world. In 2005, she moved to Seattle, Washington, and began her latest endeavor, "40 Days and 1001 Nights," in which she lived in five Muslim countries for 40 days each (Indonesia, Egypt, Zanzibar, Jordan, and China's western most predominately Muslim province). 40 Days and 1001 Nights became a book, documentary film, music CD, and dance concert. She previously authored two other books: *They Told Me I Couldn't*, about living and dancing in Colombia in the 1980's; and the instructional book *Belly Dancing for Fitness*.
